DORIC Books' latest children's title was launched on Sunday at a family activity day at Greenmyres Eco Bothy by Huntly.

The Tint Aig was written and illustrated by local author Aaron Gale. The book tells the story of a little robin redbreast, who finds a mystery egg lying on the ground and goes on a quest to find the owner.

As well as encouraging children to read and listen in Doric, the book is packed with facts and information about local birds and wildlife.

The event was well attended, with families enjoying picnics in the scenic surroundings and engaging in a variety of hands-on activities on offer.
